Bromelain is produced in the form of capsule. Each capsule contains bromelain, 500 GDU as an active ingredient, for oral use.

Bromelain is an enzyme that breaks down protein molecules and is obtained from pineapple stems. In lab experiments, bromelain prevented blood clotting and decreased inflammation. Studies show that bromelain can reduce swelling, tenderness and pain in injuries to the musculoskeletal system. Bromelain can reduce post-operative swelling and oedema and, when taken pre-surgery, can reduce the duration of pain and inflammation.

Contraindications: _____

You should NOT take bromelain if you:

- Are allergic to bromelain, pineapple and any other ingredients of this capsule.

If you are pregnant or breastfeeding, think you may be pregnant or are planning to have a baby, ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before taking this product.

bromelain capsules aren't recommended for using during pregnancy and lactation, because the safety of this supplement has not been established.

- Have history of blood clotting, bleeding or menstrual disorders.

- Anticoagulant medication such as warfarin sodium
- Tetracycline antibiotics such as doxycycline

Always take this product exactly as your doctor has told you.

Adults: Take 1 capsule, three times a day before meals.

Side effects: _____

Like all medicine, this product can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them. Possible side effects of bromelain are: gastrointestinal symptoms, including nausea, vomiting and diarrhea.

Store below 30° C and protect from light and moisture.
